1. Call to order:7:04pm, Introductions by the PTC and Principal Emily Burnett, introductions by all attendees
2. Approval of Minutes: April approved by Rachel Anderson, seconded by Jay Lerch May approved by Jennifer Coppolino, seconded by Rachel Anderson
3. President's Report:

Julie: Back to School Bash is coming up, information was sent out in the Roadrunner weekly. An invitation will be mailed out this week. Please register so we can get a headcount. You do NOT need to bring tickets with you. Back to School Bash has: information tables for clubs and organizations, spirit wear orders, hot dog dinner, free of charge with the exception of Sunset Slush which is for purchase, DJ, games, Class tug of war; over 100 people have rsvp'd already. Volunteers are needed for set up, clean up, games, etc.
The PTC has a gift for teachers for the beginning of the year; the Presidents will present to staff before school starts. They are once again asking teachers/staff for their likes/dislikes info to be used by room parents. There was a request for all room parents to get each teacher's list from the room parent coordinator.
PTC will once again recognize all of the staff on their birthdays with a small gift. Volunteer recruitment is a focus this year.
The PTC also has a gift for each of the Kindergarten families for Meet the Teacher day.
4. Treasurer's Report:

Rita: Added self-sustaining category, ie cheerleading, class party, scholastic fair, Cougars/Wolves
Last year the PTC had $\$ 30000$ income, $\$ 35000$ in expenses.
$\$ 2558$ remains in the playground fund.
Draft budget to be voted on at Sept meeting; Committees should give feedback to Rita with re: to budget allotment before the Sept meeting.
Class Party money is collected the year before so it is entered on the previous year balance but will be forwarded to the new budget (\$10/family that is collected during registration, which will be divided between Halloween, Winter and Valentine parties) PTC will continue to provide food and drink for the parties off of the district approved list. This year the book fair will be held during parent-teacher conferences instead of Winter Fest to try to increase sales.
5. Principal's Report:

Welcome from Mrs. Burnett; there are 7 new staff members, adding an art teacher part time and music teacher part time, Kindergarten teacher, 2 First grade teachers, 1 Third grade teacher and principal.

Letters were mailed last night for teacher assignments, call by the end of the week if you haven't received your letter.
Teachers report on Monday Aug 12. The first day of school, Aug. 14, is a half day. Concrete was not put in correctly on the playground. The spinner is still a concern; trying to figure out a solution to the ruts in the ground around the spinner.
Staff is looking for families to come and talk about cultures and traditions as a staff inservice; contact Mrs. Burnett if you are interested.

C. Fundraising Options: $1 \& 2$ yes; keep the other options on the table for future discussion

1. Month by Month Raffle: Each student is given 10 tickets to sell for $\$ 10$ each. Drawings will be held during the first week of the month, Oct through May, with a
bonus drawing in Dec. After each month's drawing, the winning tickets are added back to the pool of tickets and will be eligible to be drawn as winners in any future drawings. Each month's drawing has 3 winners: $\$ 100, \$ 50$, and $\$ 25$ with the December drawing including a bonus $\$ 100$ drawing, for a total of 25 chances to win. The top ticket sales in each class will earn an incentive (i.e. PJ day, extra recess)
Typical raffle participation was $10 \%$ in the past.
