September 13, 2022

1. Call to Order - Meeting called to order at 7:01pm
2. Approval of Minutes - Sarah Malcolm approved the notes and Holly 2nd the approval. Minutes were approved.
3. President's Report – Stephanie Furlong
 - There was a meeting last month, district has a presidents meeting with Dr. Tammaru and Heidi where they share any recap from the board meeting and different PTCs share information.
 - Referendum that people voted for over the Summer was approved and they have begun lining up architects to start work next Summer. It was better that it was already voted on so they can start projects next Summer.
 - Briar Glen shared that they had an ice cream social where they sold spirit wear. They sold roughly \$200 on their online sales, but at the ice cream social they had t-shirts available right there for sales and sold over \$1000 worth of shirts at the one event. Our board uses a printer for our shirts but Briar Glen shared another local company that prints within 48 hours. This something to look into as a fundraising opportunity.
 - Mrs. Burnett and Carlson are trying to get into the call. There is a benefit when it is remote, because there are more members present. Kim C. thanks everyone for their patience and flexibility. We may go a little out of order from the agenda. For now, let's go to Ariel.
4. Treasurer's Report – Ariel Steffens - Kim C. sent out the most recent budget. Ariel wanted to highlight a couple things from the budget.
 - In the last month \$2000 for fun run deposit, BTS bash \$750 for DJ and \$250 for cash tips on janitor and DJ but we didn't spend it all, so it will come back into the account. \$450 to renew directory spot. \$1800 in class party money came through
 - Next Month: Shirts from new students and some BTS expenses will hit
 - Comment: For the last couple of years, we haven't budgeted for watch dogs, but Ariel reached out to him to see what he might be looking for, so we are interested in possibly funding for him.
5. Principal's Report – Mrs. Burnett
 - Mrs. Burnett said it is so great to see so many people on the call. The last meeting was before school started. She mentioned that it has been such a successful start to the year, kids are smiling, the learning

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that has taken place is just awesome and successful. Thank you to the families and kids who came back ready to go.

6. Faculty Report – Mrs. Carlson
